## Questions to Ask When Evaluating Sources

- Who is the author/creator of this content?
  - o Is it a company or organization? An individual?
  - What do they do?
  - o Are they anonymous? If so, why do you think that is?
- When was this published?
  - o Is it recent enough to be relevant to your research?
  - If it's not very recent, is there a chance the information might be outdated and inaccurate?
- What are the author's claims?
  - What kind of evidence does the author use to support those claims? Facts? Statistics? Assumptions? Opinions?
  - Do you agree or disagree with the author's argument or perspective? Why?
- Whose voices/viewpoints are not being heard?
  - o Do the authors leave out important facts or alternative perspectives?
- What is your position on this topic?
  - What evidence (research) can you provide to support your position?
  - o Does this source make you reconsider that position?
